The Committee has further proposed following guidelines to be followed by the Private Colleges-

- 1. No other charges other than notified above shall be charged from students without approval of DMER.
- 2. There should be complete transparency and disclosure of Fee. Accordingly, the fee structure should be displayed on the college website and in all admission brochures with itemized breakdown of all fees and all policies regarding fee payment schedules, late fees, and refund policies.
- 3. All MBBS Interns and Post Graduate students shall be paid stipend at par with that being given in Government Medical Colleges.
- 4. Any additional fee which is already fixed by the University shall be charged strictly as per University charges only. The colleges can charge a maximum of 20% over as handling and administrative charges.
- 5. Hostel Charges shall not be mandatorily levied on the students in case the student wishes to not opt for the hostel facilities (subject to being allowed by NMC).
- 6. Colleges to ensure that all hostels have a fully functional Pantry/Utility Room with induction plate, microwave, large refrigerator, water cooler with RO etc. and Provision of a Laundry area installed with Full-Automatic Washing Machines in all hostels.
- 7. The annual fee shall be payable in two equal installments (6 monthly). However, parents can choose to pay the fee in Single Installment as per their convenience. The due date for deposition of Fee shall be duly notified atleast one month in advance.
- 8. All colleges shall establish a robust grievance redressal mechanism for addressing student and parent complaints regarding fees.

The revised fee, if approved by the competent authority shall be applicable from the Academic Session 2024-25 and the candidates admitted in the session 2024-25 shall have to deposit the revised fee accordingly.
